Rectory Office Hours: In emergency, parishioners can contact Father any time. **Mondays-Day Off - office closed.**

Church Membership: All faithful are welcome to our Church. Ukrainian Catholics, Roman Catholics and Orthodox people can pray with us. We would love to see at our Church non-Catholics and unaffiliated people. If any of the visitors feels that our Church is a house of prayer and spiritual life, this person can become a Christian and member of our parish. We appreciate all contributions for the Church to cover expenses of our Parish. You may use your envelopes.

Baptism: All people can become Christians. Children can become Christians through the consent of the parents. According to our Ukrainian-Byzantine custom Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion is combined into one service. For adults Catechetical preparation is required.

First Confession and Solemn Holy Communion: Every baptized adult must go to Confession at least once a year. Children after the age of 8 have to receive First Penance and Holy Communion according to the Church's Law. Catechetical classes are available in our parish. Please sign up your child for classes at least one year before the day of the event.

Confession is available 30 min. before every Liturgy & at other times by requesting the priest.

Marriages All couples contemplating marriage are required to attend counseling sessions. A period of six months is needed for all preparations. Please contact Father as soon as you make plans to wed.

Anointing of the Home-bound Due to Illness: If you are home-bound and would like Father to visit you, please call the office to make sure your name is on the list. It is the family's responsibility to inform the pastor on time, especially of an emergency.

Funeral: Have your funeral director contact the rectory immediately after the death to make proper funeral arrangements.

Parish Ukrainian School: Parish Ukrainian school is now open. The schedule is Saturdays from 9:30AM to 1:30PM. Children of all ages are invited. **Запрошуємо до суботньої Української Школи всіх дітей різного віку! (732) 505-6053**

“SCHOLARSHIP of St. Stephen Parish”: A scholarship of \$500 is available from our parish to high school graduating students. To be eligible, graduating students must attend the Liturgy and services every Sunday and be active in the parish at least 3 years before graduation.

Religion education is temporarily unavailable. The religion classes are provided by Fr. Volodymyr every available Sunday at the coffee hour after the Divine Liturgy.

Important to know:

EXTREME UNCTION: Extreme Unction should be administered by a priest of that Rite to which the person belongs. In case of emergency any Catholic priest can administer this Sacrament.

BURIAL: All the faithful must be buried by a priest of their own Rite (Can. 1216). Cremations are not recommended. All funeral services must be done before cremation.

MATRIMONY: Marriage between Catholics of different Rites must take place in the Rite of the groom and be blessed by his pastor. The marriage ceremony of Catholics of the same Rite usually takes place in the parish church of the bride (Can. 83, 3).

ATTENDANCE AT MASS (DIVINE LITURGY): Eastern Rite Catholics should attend Liturgy on Sundays and Holydays of obligation in their own church, if there is one in the place in which they live. (E.R. Can. 2).

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION-CONFESSION: First Holy Communion ought to be received in the Rite to which the parents belong. If there is a diversity of Rites, all children should receive First Holy Communion in the Rite and the parish of the father (if parents have no understanding of each other). All faithful should receive their Easter Communion, if possible, in their own Rite and parish church. The same rule applies to Easter Confession (Can. 866, 2 & 859, 3).

ABSTINENCE: Ukrainian Catholics must keep abstinence, that is, they must abstain from meat every Friday of the year, except during the so-called “Zahalnytsi” or Compact Weeks. Ukrainian church has the following “abstinence” periods: 1. Advent (Pylypivka, from Nov. 15 to Dec. 24); 2. “Petrivka” from the Monday following All Saints Sunday up to the feast of the Apostles Peter and Paul; 3. “Spasivka” from Aug. 1 to Aug. 14 (Transfiguration of our Lord); 4. Lent (Great Fast) begins on the Monday after Cheesefare Sunday until Resurrection of our Lord. All these periods are forbidden time for any celebrating of marriages, hold dances and amusements with music.

ADVANTAGES OF THE HOLY COMMUNION: Holy Communion unites our soul with Jesus Christ, increases the amount of sanctifying grace within soul, forgives venial sins and the punishment due to mortal sins which have already been forgiven, preserves the soul against sin, helps the soul to do all things well and to fulfill properly the duties of its state of life.

“Rosary of the Divine Mercy – Вервиця до Божого Милосердя”:

Using Rosary beads, begin with:

Our Father..., Hail Mary..., the Apostles' Creed...

On the large bead before each decade say:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those that needs your mercy.

On the ten small beads of each decade:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

After the last decade, recite the following prayer three times:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world (3 times)

Jesus invites everyone: *“Come to Me, all you who are weary and are burdened, and I will relieve you!”*

Prayer: *“O Lord God, bless all people of the USA to live in the peace, faith, hope and love to You and all people in the country. Protect all lives, especially unborn children”!*

Prayer: “O Lord, Jesus Christ, our God, grant that our hearts become the altar of Your love, that our lips proclaim Your bountiful mercy, that our eyes constantly gaze into the wound of Your most Sacred Heart, that our minds meditate upon Your unfathomable perfections, that our memory guard the precious souvenirs of Your mercy. O Lord, our God, let everything within us praise the ineffable love of Your most Sacred Heart, for Your name is blessed, of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, now and forever, world without end”. Amen

Prayer for unborn Children:

“O Most Holy Blessed Mother who carried the “Source of All Life” in your virginal holy womb; intercede with your tenderly maternal love and graces answering our prayers to end abortion and save precious infant lives. Amen”
