Church Membership: All Faithful are welcome to our Church. Ukrainian Catholics, Roman Catholics and Orthodox people can pray with us. We would love to see at our Church non-Catholics and unaffiliated people. If any of the visitors will feel that our

Church is a home of prayer and spiritual life, this person can become a Christian and member of our parish. We appreciate all contributions for the Church to cover expenses of our Parish. You may use your envelopes.

<u>Baptisms:</u> All people can become Christians. Children can become Christians through the free will of the parents. According to our Ukrainian-Byzantine custom we give Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion in one service. For adults there is needed catechetical preparation.

<u>First Penance and Solemn Holy Communion</u>: Every adult Baptized has to receive Penance at least once a year. Children after the age of 8 have to receive First Penance and Holy Communion according to the Church's Law. Catechetical classes are available in our parish. Please sign up your child for classes at least one year before the day of the event.

<u>Confession</u> is available 30 min. before every Liturgy & other times by request of the priest.

<u>Marriages</u> All couples contemplating marriage are required to attend counseling sessions. Please contact Father as soon as you make plans to wed.

Anointing of the Home-bound Due to Illness: If you are home-bound and would like Father to visit you, please call the office to make sure your name is on the list. It is the family's responsibility to inform the pastor on time, especially of an emergency.

Funeral: Have your funeral director contact the rectory immediately after the death to make proper funeral arrangements.

Parish Ukrainian School: Parish Ukrainian school will start on September 30. The school days are Saturdays from 9:00am to 12.30pm. "SCHOLARSHIP of St. Stephen Parish": A scholarship of \$500 is available from our parish to high school graduating students. To receive this, graduating students would have to visit our parish every Sunday and be active in the parish at least 3 years before graduation.

Below is information concerning a course: BYZANTINE ONLINE COURSE ON THE UGCC "CHRIST OUR PASCHA" CATECHISM! Byzantine Christian Catechesis and Christ Our Pascha: A Study of the Ukrainian Greek-Catholic Catechism. You and catechists may find this online course beneficial and enriching for your parish catechetical program. This post-baccalaureate course explores the three main pillars of Byzantine Christian catechesis – the Faith of the Church, the Worship of the Church, and the Life of the Church – as presented in Christ Our Pascha, the Catechism of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church. Story of installation of the feast of Mary's protraction (pokrov):

In 911 the Mohammedan hordes attacked city Constantinople during the reign of Emperor Leo the Wise. The terror-stricken people gathered within the church to pray to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Mother of God saved them from utter destruction and captivity. St. Andrew and his disciple St. Theophanius, **both from Ukraine**, entered the church of the Holy Wisdom where the people were praying all night while the Christian army fought against the attacking Saracens. At dawn St. Andrew and St. Theophanius saw the Blessed Virgin appearing with outstretched arms and imploring God's mercy upon the besieged Christians. She held a veil (omophor) over the attacked city as a sign of assured protection. To the great joy of the inhabitants the Christian soldiers were blessed with a striking victory over the Moslems. On their return home the two Saints publicized the miracle among our people. Thus the feast of "Pokrova" (Patronage) of the Blessed Virgin Mary was introduced into the Church to denote Mary's protection over our people. This feast day is very popular in Ukraine. Holy Mother of God is protecting every one who is asking her for help.
