Rectory Office Hours: Parishioners can contact Father at any time, especially in an emergency. Mondays - Day Off.

Church Membership: All Faithful are welcome to our Church. Ukrainian Catholics, Roman Catholics and Orthodox people can pray with us. We would love to see at our Church non-Catholics and unaffiliated people. Everyone can come to Jesus and He can give to all His Blessing and Salvation. Come and worship with us our Lord. Welcome! If some of the visitors will feel that our Church is a home of prayer and spiritual life, this person can become a member of our parish. We appreciate all contributions for the Church to cover all expenses of our Parish. You can use your envelopes.

Baptisms: All people can become Christians. That is the will of God. Children can become Christians through free will of the parents. According to our Ukrainian-Byzantine custom we give Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion during one service. For adults there is needed catechetical preparation. Please contact the Pastor and make an appointment.

First Penance and Solemn First Holy Communion: Every adult Baptized has to receive Penance at least once a year. Children after the age of 8 have to receive First Penance and Holy Communion according to Church's Law. Catechetical classes are available in our Parish. Please sign your Child up for classes at least one year before the day of the event.

Confession is available 30 min. before every Liturgy & other times by request of the Priest.

Marriages All couples contemplating marriage are required to attend counseling sessions. Please contact Father as soon as you make plans to wed.

Anointing of the Sick/Illnesses Homebound If you are homebound and would like Father to visit you, please call the office to make sure your name is on the list. If you are admitted into the hospital, please contact Father as soon as possible to inform him of your admittance. Due to hospital confidentiality rules, the hospitals no longer contact the clergy without permission. Responsibility of the family is to inform the pastor on time, especially of an emergency.

FUNERAL- Have your funeral director contact the rectory immediately after the death to make proper funeral arrangements.

Sanctuary Lamp - You can dedicate the Sanctuary Lamp in memory of a loved one or in honor/thanksgiving by using the special offering envelope with the date you have chosen. Drop off the dedication and your donation of \$20 into the Sunday collection basket. Names needed. Your offering will be announced in the weekly church bulletin.

Church Flowers- Can be sponsored weekly. Parishioners can sponsor these flowers in memory of a loved one, or for any occasion. Anyone interested in sponsoring flowers, please call the rectory.

LITURGY REQUEST- Please make Divine Liturgy intentions for your loved ones. For this time the parish has not received intentions. Weekdays are available to serve the Divine Liturgy. The Family has the choice to pick a time of service of the Divine Liturgy on week days. You can make request by calling Father or by using the envelopes.

Catechism of the Catholic Church:

Цнотливість і гомосексуалізм – Chastity and homosexuality:

2357 Гомосексуалізм означає стосунки між чоловіками або між жінками, які відчувають винятковий або переважаючий сексуальний потяг до осіб такої ж статі. Він набирав найбільш різноманітних форм упродовж століть і культур. Його психічне походження залишається загалом нез'ясованим. Спираючись на Святе Письмо, яке розглядає гомосексуальні дії як важкі спотворення (Пор. Бут. 19, 1-29; Рми. 1, 24-27; 1 Кор. 6, 9-10; 1 Тим. 1, 10.), Церковна Традиція завжди проголошувала, що «акти гомосексуалізму за самою своєю внутрішньою природою є невпорядкованими» (Конгрегація віровчення, Декл. «Persona humana», 8.). Вони суперечать природному законові і виключають із сексуального акту дар життя. Вони не виникають із правдивого чуттєвого і сексуального взаємодоповнення. У жодному випадку вони не можуть бути виправдані.

2358 Немало чоловіків і жінок мають глибоко закорінені гомосексуальні нахили. Такий нахил, об'єктивно невпорядкований, для більшості з них є випробуванням. Таких людей треба сприймати з повагою, співчуттям і тактовністю. У ставленні до них слід уникати будь-яких ознак несправедливої дискримінації. Ці особи покликані виконати Божу волю у своєму житті і, якщо вони є християнами, долучити до жертви на Хресті Господа ті труднощі, з якими вони можуть зустрітися з огляду на свій стан.

2359 Гомосексуальні особи покликані до цнотливості. Через чесноти панування над собою, які вчать внутрішньої свободи, інколи через підтримку безкорисливої приязні, через молитву і сакраментальну благодать вони можуть і повинні поступово й рішуче наближатися до християнської досконалості.

(Eng.) 2357 Homosexuality refers to relations between men or between women who experience an exclusive or predominant sexual attraction toward persons of the same sex. It has taken a great variety of forms through the centuries and in different cultures. Its psychological genesis remains largely unexplained. Basing itself on Sacred Scripture, which presents homosexual acts as acts of grave depravity,140 tradition has always declared that "homosexual acts are intrinsically disordered."141 They are contrary to the natural law. They close the sexual act to the gift of life. They do not proceed from a genuine affective and sexual complementarity. Under no circumstances can they be approved.

2358 The number of men and women who have deep-seated homosexual tendencies is not negligible. This inclination, which is objectively disordered, constitutes for most of them a trial. They must be accepted with respect, compassion, and sensitivity. Every sign of unjust discrimination in their regard should be avoided. These persons are called to fulfill God's will in their lives and, if they are Christians, to unite to the sacrifice of the Lord's Cross the difficulties they may encounter from their condition.

2359 Homosexual persons are called to chastity. By the virtues of self-mastery that teach them inner freedom, at times by the support of disinterested friendship, by prayer and sacramental grace, they can and should gradually and resolutely approach Christian perfection.
