<u>Church Membership:</u> All Faithful are welcome to our Church. Ukrainian Catholics, Roman Catholics and Orthodox people can pray with us. We would love to see at our Church non-Catholics and unaffiliated people. Everyone can come to Jesus and He can give to all His Blessing and Salvation. Come and worship with us our Lord. Welcome! If some of the visitors will feel that our Church is a home of prayer and spiritual life, this person can become a member of our parish. We appreciate all contributions for the Church to cover the expenses of our Parish. You can use your envelopes.

<u>Baptisms:</u> All people can become Christians. That is the will of God. Children can become Christians through free will of the parents. According to our Ukrainian-Byzantine custom we confer Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion in one service. For adults there is needed catechetical preparation. Please contact the Pastor and make an appointment.

<u>First Penance and Solemn First Holy Communion</u>: Every adult Baptized has to receive Penance at least once a year. Children after the age of 8 have to receive First Penance and Holy Communion according to Church's Law. Catechetical classes are available in our Parish. Please sign your Child up for classes at least one year before the day of the event.

Confession is available 30 min. before every Liturgy & other times by request of the Priest.

<u>Marriages</u> All couples contemplating marriage are required to attend counseling sessions. Please contact Father as soon as you make plans to wed.

Anointing of the Sick/Illnesses Homebound If you are homebound and would like Father to visit you, please call the office to make sure your name is on the list. Responsibility of the family is to inform the pastor on time, especially of an emergency.

FUNERAL- Have your funeral director contact the rectory immediately after the death to make proper funeral arrangements.

<u>Sanctuary Lamp</u> - You can dedicate the Sanctuary Lamp in memory of a loved one or in honor/thanksgiving by using the special offering envelope with the date you have chosen. Drop off the dedication and your donation of \$20 into the Sunday collection basket. Names needed.

Church Flowers- Can be sponsored weekly. Parishioners can sponsor these flowers in memory of a loved one, or for any occasion. Anyone interested in sponsoring flowers, please call the rectory.

<u>LITURGY REQUEST</u>- Please make Divine Liturgy intentions for your loved ones. Weekdays are available to serve the Divine Liturgy. The family has the choice to pick a time of service of the Divine Liturgy on week days.

<u>BINGO INFORMATION</u>- Every Tuesday we have Bingo at our parish hall. The income of Bingo can help cover our expenses of the mortgage for the new church.

<u>ROSARY SOCIETY</u>- Our Parish has a very spiritual group called the Rosary Society. The group keeps the will of the Holy Mother of God to pray on the Rosary every day.

<u>RELIGION EDUCATION-</u> To be educated in the religious life, our parish will have Catechetical classes every Sunday for children at 10:00am. Teacher Sandy provide classes of Catechism for Sundays.

Father Volodymyr provides Catechism for children on Saturdays at 12.30pm and classes for adult parishioners and visitors on Sundays during "Coffee hour" time at 12:00pm in parish hall.

<u>UKRAINIAN "NADIYA DANCE SCHOOL"</u> – Dance classes are provided by choreographer Nadiya Lemega in our parish hall every Thursday at 6:30pm. All children are welcome! Please call the Rectory.

"Catechism of the Catholic Church": Християнське ім'я – The Christian Name: 2156 Таїнство Хрещення вділяється «в ім'я Отця, і Сина, і Святого Духа» (Мт. 28,19). У Хрещенні ім'я Господа освячує людину, і християнин отримує своє ім'я в Церкві. То може бути ім'я святого, тобто учня, який прожив життя у взірцевій вірності своєму Господові. Покров такого святого становить взірець любові і забезпечує його заступництво. «Хресне ім'я» може виражати ще християнське таїнство чи християнську чесноту. «Батьки, хресні батьки і парох мають пильнувати за тим, щоб не давалося ім'я, чуже християнському духові» (Кодекс канонічного права, кан. 855). 2157 Християнин розпочинає свій день, свої молитви і свої дії знаком Хреста «в ім'я Отця, і Сина, і Святого Духа. Амінь». Хрещений посвячує свій день Славі Божій і просить благодаті Спасителя, яка дозволяє йому діяти в Дусі як дитині Отця свого. Знак Хреста зміцнює нас перед спокусами та в труднощах. 2158 Бог кличе кожного за власним ім'ям (Пор. Іс. 43, 1; Ів. 10,3.). Ім'я кожної людини є святим. Ім'я є іконою особи. Воно вимагає пошани - як виразу гідності того, хто його носить. 2159 Отримане ім'я залишається навічно. У Небеснім Царстві таїнственний та унікальний характер кожної людини, позначеної Іменем Бога, засяє в повному світлі. «Переможному (...) дам камінчик білий і на камінчику - ім'я нове написане, не знане нікому, крім того, хто його приймає» (Од. 2,17). «І глянув я, і от Агнець стоїть на горі Сіоні, і з ним сто сорок чотири тисячі, що мають Ім'я Його та Ім'я Отця Його, написане на чолах своїх» (Од. 14,1).

2156 The sacrament of Baptism is conferred "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."85 In Baptism, the Lord's name sanctifies man, and the Christian receives his name in the Church. This can be the name of a saint, that is, of a disciple who has lived a life of exemplary fidelity to the Lord. the patron saint provides a model of charity; we are assured of his intercession. the "baptismal name" can also express a Christian mystery or Christian virtue. "Parents, sponsors, and the pastor are to see that a name is not given which is foreign to Christian sentiment."86 2157 The Christian begins his day, his prayers, and his activities with the Sign of the Cross: "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." the baptized person dedicates the day to the glory of God and calls on the Savior's grace which lets him act in the Spirit as a child of the Father. the sign of the cross strengthens us in temptations and difficulties.2158 God calls each one by name.87 Everyone's name is sacred. the name is the icon of the person. It demands respect as a sign of the dignity of the one who bears it. 2159 The name one receives is a name for eternity. In the kingdom, the mysterious and unique character of each person marked with God's name will shine forth in splendor. "To him who conquers . . . I will give a white stone, with a new name written on the stone which no one knows except him who receives it. "88 "Then I looked, and Lo, on Mount Zion stood the Lamb, and with him a hundred and forty-four thousand who had his name and his Father's name written on their foreheads."89
