Rectory Office Hours: Parishioners can contact Father at any time, especially in an emergency. Mondays - Day Off.

Church Membership: All Faithful are welcome to our Church. Ukrainian Catholics, Roman Catholics and Orthodox people can pray with us. We would love to see at our Church non-Catholics and unaffiliated people. Everyone can come to Jesus and He can give to all His Blessing and Salvation. Come and worship our Lord with us. If some of the visitors will feel that our Church is a home of prayer and spiritual life, this person can become a Christian and member of our parish. We appreciate all contributions for the Church to cover expenses of our Parish. You may use your envelopes.

<u>Baptisms:</u> All people can become Christians. That is the will of God. Children can become Christians through free will of the parents. According to our Ukrainian-Byzantine custom we give Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion in one service. For adults there is needed catechetical preparation. Please contact the Pastor and make an appointment.

<u>First Penance and Solemn Holy Communion</u>: Every adult Baptized has to receive Penance at least once a year. Children after the age of 8 have to receive First Penance and Holy Communion according to Church's Law. Catechetical classes are available in our parish. Please sign up your child for classes at least one year before the day of the event.

Confession is available 30 min. before every Liturgy & other times by request of the Priest.

<u>Marriages</u> All couples contemplating marriage are required to attend counseling sessions. Please contact Father as soon as you make plans to wed.

Anointing of the Home-bound Due to illness: If you are home-bound and would like Father to visit you, please call the office to make sure your name is on the list. It is the family's responsibility to inform the pastor on time, especially of an emergency.

<u>Funeral-</u> Have your funeral director contact the rectory immediately after the death to make proper funeral arrangements.

<u>Sanctuary Lamp</u> - You can dedicate the Sanctuary Lamp in memory of a loved one or in honor/thanksgiving by using the special offering envelope with the date you have chosen. Drop off the dedication and your donation of \$20 into the Sunday collection basket. Names needed.

<u>Church Flowers</u>. May be sponsored weekly. Parishioners can sponsor these flowers in memory of a loved one, or for any occasion. When interested in sponsoring flowers, please call the rectory.

<u>Liturgy request</u>- Please make Divine Liturgy intentions for your loved ones. Weekdays are available to serve the Divine Liturgy. The family has the choice to pick a time of service of the Divine Liturgy on week days.

<u>Bingo information</u>- Every Tuesday we have Bingo at our parish hall. The income of Bingo is helping us to cover our expenses of the mortgage for the our new church.

Rosary society- Our Parish has a very spiritual group called the Rosary Society. The group keeps the will of the Holy Mother of God to pray on the Rosary every day.

Religion education- To be educated in the religious life, our parish has Catechetical classes every Sunday for children at 10:00am. Teacher Sandy provides the classes of Catechism for Sundays.

On Saturdays at 12.30pm, Fr. Volodymyr provides Catechetical classes for second group of children. The religion classes for adult parishioners and visitors, Fr. Volodymyr provides on Sundays, during "Coffee hour" time at 12:00pm in parish hall.

<u>Ukrainian "NADIYA DANCE SCHOOL</u>" – Ukrainian Dance classes provides choreographer Nadiya Lemega on every Thursday at 6:30pm at our parish hall. All children are welcome! Please call the Rectory.

Circumcision was a religious rite among the Jews God made it a sign of His covenant with the Israelites. It was performed with a ritual knife on boys on the eighth day after birth. At the same time a name was given. In the New Testament the obligation of circumcision was abolished by the Church because it was a distinctive mark of the Old Testament.

The feast of the Circumcision is kept by the Church to commemorate the subjection of the Child Jesus to the Law of Moses. This feast was introduced in the fourth century. The feast of St. Basil the Great also falls on the same day. St. Basil the Great was archbishop of Cesarea and a Doctor of the Church. He is called Patriarch of the Eastern monks, for he composed the first rule for them. The Western Orders adopted many monastic regulations from the rule of St. Basil.

St. Basil the Great edited the Divine Liturgy (Mass) which is sung ten times a year in the Ukrainian Rite. He was also a staunch defender of the Catholic faith against the Arian heresy. He died on January 1, 379.
