Rectory Office Hours: In emergency parishioners can contact Father any time. Mondays-Day Off - office closed. Church Membership: All Faithful are welcome to our Church. Ukrainian Catholics, Roman Catholics and Orthodox people can pray with us. We would love to see at our Church non-Catholics and unaffiliated people. If any of the visitors will feel that our Church is a home of prayer and spiritual life, this person can become a Christian and member of our parish. We appreciate all contributions for the Church to cover expenses of our Parish. You may use your envelopes.

Baptisms: All people can become Christians. Children can become Christians through the free will of the parents. According to our Ukrainian-Byzantine custom we give Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion in one service. For adults there is needed catechetical preparation.

First Penance and Solemn Holy Communion: Every adult Baptized has to receive Penance at least once a year. Children after the age of 8 have to receive First Penance and Holy Communion according to the Church's Law. Catechetical classes are available in our parish. Please sign up your child for classes at least one year before the day of the event.

Confession is available 30 min, before every Liturgy & other times by request of the priest.

Marriages All couples contemplating marriage are required to attend counseling sessions. Please contact Father as soon as you make plans to wed.

Anointing of the Home-bound Due to Illness: If you are home-bound and would like Father to visit you, please call the office to make sure your name is on the list. It is the family's responsibility to inform the pastor on time, especially of an emergency.

Funeral: Have your funeral director contact the rectory immediately after the death to make proper funeral arrangements.

Parish Ukrainian School: Parish Ukrainian school is on summer break, resuming in September. The school days are Saturdays from 9:00am to 12.30pm. The children participate in this school and their teacher Maria Ivanus leads these classes. Children of all ages are invited. Запрошуємо до суботньюї Української Школи всіх дітей різного віку!

"SCHOLARSHIP of St. Stephen Parish": A scholarship of \$500 is available from our parish to high school graduating students. To receive this, graduating students would have to visit our parish every Sunday and be active in the parish at least 3 years before graduation.

Rosary Society- Our Parish has a very spiritual group called the Rosary Society. The group keeps the will of the Holy Mother of God to pray the Rosary every day.

Religion education- To be educated in the religious life, our parish has Catechetical classes.

The religion classes for adult parishioners and visitors Fr. Volodymyr provides on Sundays during "Coffee hour" time at 12:00pm in the parish hall.

Metropolitan-Archbishop Stefan Soroka is pleased to announce that our newly nominated Auxiliary Bishop Andriy Rabiy will be ordained by His Beatitude Sviatoslav Shevchuk during the opening Hierarchical Divine Liturgy for the Synod of Bishops to take place on Sunday, September 3rd, 2017 in St. George Ukrainian Catholic Cathedral in Lviv, Ukraine at 11:00am. Co-consecrators will be Archbishop Stefan Soroka and Bishop David Motiuk, Eparch of Edmonton Eparchy (Canada). The newly ordained Bishop Andriy Rabiy will be formally welcomed in the Ukrainian Catholic Archdiocese of Philadelphia with his celebrating a Hierarchical Divine Liturgy in the Ukrainian Catholic Cathedral in Philadelphia, PA on Sunday, September 24, 2017 at 3:00pm. Bishop Andriy was born in Ukraine and received his education in the Catholic University of Washington, DC. All faithful are welcome! Historical Mission:

The Holy See of Rome had entrusted our people with a special honorable mission of converting our separated brethren of the East. Pope Urban 8th said in 1629 to Methodius Terletsky, bishop of Kholm, and Pope Benedict 15th repeated it in 1921 to Metropolitan Andrew Sheptysky: "O my Ukrainians, through your meditation I hope that the East will be converted". This shall be done, said Benedict 15th, because they showed their courage during the Russian persecutions of their Church during World War 1. There are about 200,000,000 Eastern Rite Christians who remain outside the Catholic Church. Their conversion is the historical mission of the Ukrainian Catholic Church (AAS. May 1921).
